## Old Business

Dick Baker reported that advertizements in KPFA folder had brought increased attendance. Dr. Duke reported same for Peninsula area. The latter amointed to look into further advertizing possibilities.

Treasurer's report: \$369. received, \$479. expended; assets on hand, \$2479.13. Also \$275. in fund for Rev. Katagiri's family's arrival; agreed to add \$25.00 to make even \$300. Treasurer to give amount to Kev. Katagiri.

On matter of drums and bells, Rev.: Suzuki advised that drum would cost about \$370.00 with \$30.00 additional shipping cost. It was decided that this would be a suitable occasion for drawing on the Hazel Paget Memorial Fund, and authorization was given to purchase dram.

In regard to revising main hall for zazen purposes, Rev. Suzuki reported that basic revision would be needed; Dick Baker urged student participation to reduce costs.

## New Business

It was decided next Sesshin would be December 11, next business meeting Dec.18

Matter of increase in our financial contribution toward each priest was brought up; decision to postpone until following meeting.

Ways and means of raising needed money discussed: decision to post signs on bulletin board, one in regard to Sesshin contributions, and one permanent one to be posted by Treasurer. Also decision to have traditional plate not passed but at door on Sundays.

With regard to Professor Masunaga, who is working on translation of Shobo Genzit was suggested by Rev. Suzuki that we send \$20.00 per month in support of the translator, who in turn will send a lecture (in English) each month. So voted.

Trudy Dixon asked approval that all library books be recalled as of January for inventory purposes. Recall approved.
