- 3) Dick Baker said that he would put advertisements in the KQED and KPFA bulletins and in the Saturday Review of Literature.
- 4) Jean Ross announced the visit of a nuclear physics professor from Kyoto University on the coming Wednesday evening, July 7th, to speak about the relation between science and Zen.
- 5) Grahame Petchey resigned as Vice President and from the Board of Trustees because of his impending year's absence from Zen Center while he is in Japan. Phillip Wilson also resigned as Trustee for the same reason. Jean Ross wished them both luck, and said that soon a meeting of the trustees would be held to fill the vacancies.

- 7) Claude Dalenberg asked about the plans for renting or buying the house around the corner from the temple on Laguna Street. Jean Ross thought we ought to rent it with the option to buy. Dick Baker said it might be better to buy it, paying installments on a loan instead of rent. Dick said he would call about it. George Hagiwara is also looking into it.
