THOUGHTS ARE THINGS

All form is the product of ideas shaped, or imaged, or thought about, in the mind. The originating idea of any form induces thought and the thought becomes the image. This image in mind is as material as its ultimate manifest form.

This principle applies just as ably to abstract qualities. The manifest experience of joy is an extension of an invisible "image" or thought. Both are material.

The moment you begin to handle any idea with your mind --- extending outward as something tangible --- you have encompassed the formless, spiritual essence, with a form and are interpreting (demonstrating) according to your understanding and appreciation. All form is the result of the extension of spiritual essence or ideas. First the idea, then the thought, then the manifestation.

Thoughts are things. Back of thought is a vast sea of formless substance, generally designated as divine ideas, ready to take instant shape according to your thought. You can dip into this ocean of Good --- for it is All-Good --- to your heart's content and bring forth any thing you wish. Every thought you think is a step in the process of utilizing the formless Good as your desire.

All form, and consequently, all thought, is subject to change --rearrangement, comparison, and evaluation. This alone indicates its
impermanency, its tendency to destruction, for, the instant a form is changed
(whether or not for the better) it is destroyed and a different form appears no
matter how slight the degree of change.

Again, thoughts are things and things have no value in Spirit. Things are but the shadow cast by Spirit. When you confine your dealing with shadows cast, you are attending to that which has no substance, that which perishes as the mist. Your shadow holds no value for you. It simply indicates you are there. It is because of you.

People work desperately to change their thoughts for the better, to hold good thoughts. This is a terrific strain on the energies, for, the cause of thought not being considered, all such effort finally proves futile.

It is admittedly profitable to think good thoughts. However, when the whole effort is bent in dealing with the quality of thoughts and thinking in sufficient quantity to insure successful demonstration, the mind is encumbered with a practice not particularly satisfactory --- if not altogether harmful.

The question arises, What then, is a profitable exercise of the mind? The one answer containing a germ of beneficial instruction is, Get acquainted with THAT which precedes thought.

What determines thought? The direction of your attention toward some objective before thinking about it. You first gaze toward it with an inner

visional faculty, a capacity to look, before you begin to think. This "looking toward" is not with the sight of the outer eyes; it is a perception within.

Since God is Good and the Source of any good you want, whether qualities or visible things, it is profitable to first GIVE your attention (that which enables you to formulate "images" of the Good), to Him. An advanced realization is that the Good itself knows BEST how to formulate itself. But we learn step by step.

"Look unto Me," "Seek my face ever more," "Watch," "Seek first the Kingdom of God," "Lift up your eyes, and look," are but a few commands indicating the primary essential to successful thinking and demonstration.
